

"Lights On, Abuse Off Pinwheels for Prevention campaign"



April is Child Abuse Prevention Month and a group of 9th and 10th grade students are organizing a day to show their support by participating in the national Pinwheel for Prevention campaign, with a twist. The pinwheel is the symbol for child abuse and neglect prevention nationwide. It represents the efforts to change the way the nation thinks about prevention, focusing on community activities and public policies that prioritize prevention from the start to make sure child abuse and neglect never occur. Child abuse and neglect covers every ethnicity, every age and every community, whether you're in the inner city, suburbs or rural area.

This class of students is asking the school and community members to make a donation by purchasing a **LED light-up Pinwheel** to display in a Pinwheel garden at the school on April 30th. The students added their own twist to the campaign by asking the community to show even more support by turning their porch lights on from 9pm-11pm to show their support of this important issue in communities nationwide. The pinwheel garden will be lit and porch lights glowing on Monday evening.

The money raised will be **donated** to a local organization, **A Safe Place**, which serves residents of Warren and Forest Counties. They provide **FREE** confidential Services to men, women and **CHILDREN** who are victims of Domestic Violence and Sexual Assault.
