

Dear Parents, Guardians and Students,

Due to the icy weather conditions, TCCS will be using a remote instruction day (RID) for December 02, 2025. RID days are asynchronous instructional days; they are not meant to be synchronous. Meaning instruction is not delivered via a Google Meet or Zoom Meeting. Students work at their own pace during the time of their choosing. Teachers, special education case managers, school nurses, administrations, mental health, and all other staff will be available via email between 8:00 - 3:00 to respond to and assist students' questions. This is not instructional time, simply availability to assist if needed.

During Remote Instruction Days, teachers will be required to provide your child(ren) with instruction and/or assignments that are relevant to their curriculum. For many, posting these assignments in Google Classrooms will be sufficient, however for those students without the internet, they will be provided a hard copy of the assignment upon their return and allowed one school day to complete the assignment. They must bring in a note, written by a parent/guardian, that explains the reason why the student was unable to access their assignment online on December 2nd. Elementary teachers have given all their students hard copies of their assignments. Middle School and High School teachers have spoken to their students and what their assignments will be if we use a remote instructional day.

Student Attendance: Students are expected to submit their assignment(s) the day after a remote instruction day in order to receive credit for attendance and/or credit for the assignment. If students do not submit their assignments they will be considered absent, and will need to submit an excuse to the attendance officer. Assignments are due tomorrow Wednesday, December 3rd.

Make Up Day: Due to using a RID for December 2nd, students will not need to make this day up like a snow day would be.

Again, the assignments were sent home **or** posted online in Google Classroom in case we have a remote instructional day.

We thank each of you for taking part in this endeavor, it is a new experience for TCCS. We will be learning with you and do our best to make this the best learning experience for your child.
